

Location and Transformation - Students will identify and describe turns, flips and slides. They will interpret simple maps and describe the location of features in relation to other


Money and Financial Mathematics - Students will count collections of coins and notes, read and write money amounts and compare money amounts.

Students will examine how living things, including plants and animals, change as they grow. They ask questions about, investigate and compare the changes that occur to different living things during their life stages. Students will conduct investigations including exploring the growth and life stages of a class animal and plant.
