## This funding will be used to

Assist Collingwood Park State School staff to reach the following targets:

- 85% of students achieving a 'C' or above in English, Maths and Science
- 35% of students achieving an A/B in English, Maths and Science
- 95% of Year 3 and 5 students reaching National Minimum Standard in Reading, Writing, Numeracy, Spelling and Grammar and Punctuation
- 100% of students with diverse needs, including disability, EAL/D and Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander students supported to succeed
- 100% of students know what they are learning and what they need to do to improve
- 95% or greater attendance.

## Our initiatives include

- Additional staffing to support development of teacher capability and improve student learning outcomes
- Introduction of new programs to support student learning outcomes, wellbeing and engagement
- Embedding the use of student data to inform teaching and learning programs
- Embedding internal and external moderation processes to improve teacher knowledge of the Australian Curriculum and planning teaching and learning programs to support all students to succeed.
